Installer – 1 position

The Installer is primarily responsible for on-site service and repair of doors and windows, based on an assigned schedule. Additionally, they are responsible to ensure that all product testing, troubleshooting, and repair are completed properly, to the satisfaction of our customers, and in accordance of manufacturer's specifications.

Millwork Production Associate – 2 positions

Door shop associate applies trim legs and head to door unit with nail gun, while inspecting the entire unit for quality.

Yard Associate – 1 position

Yard associates are responsible for providing excellent customer service while handling merchandise, unloading or loading trucks, and waiting on customers.

Driver Helper – 2 positions

Driver helpers assist with loading and unloading the delivery of building materials, doors and windows.

Inside Sales Representative – 1 position

The Inside Sales Representative will be responsible for sales and service at the sales counter and answering sales calls, proactively gaining and maintaining new accounts, completing home and garage take-offs, completing door and window sales.

Logistics Coordinator/Assistant Dispatcher – 1 position

The function of the Logistics Coordinator/Assistant Dispatcher is to provide support and oversight for our fleet of local drivers and support team at our HSV location. The Logistics Coordinator/Assistant Dispatcher will also be responsible for providing leadership and support in conjunction with and in the absence of the Dispatcher.

Delivery drivers will deliver windows, doors, lumber and materials. Drivers may be driving box trucks or flatbed trailers.
